

Tequila Glossary

Agave

What tequila is made from. It's not a cactus but a member of the lily family and only blue agave may be used for tequila and all of our tequilas are made from 100% blue agave unless otherwise indicated.

Añejos

At a minimum añejos get 1 year of aging in wood and some receive up to 5 years and this treatment results in a flavor profile comparable with fine scotch and cognac.

Blancos

Are also known as white, silver or plata, blancos are aged a maximum of 30 days and offer the best pure expression of blue agave flavor.

Joven Abocado

This is blanco tequila with caramel coloring added to give it an aged appearance and create the ubiquitous gold tequila sold everywhere in the United States but rarely seen in Mexico.

Licores

Sweet, tequila based liqueurs, infused with various special flavors.

Los Altos Tequila

These tequilas from the highlands northeast of Guadalajara and tend to have a "fruity" character.

Lowland Tequila

Tequilas from this area southwest of Guadalajara, surrounding the town of Tequila, generally have more wood and earth flavors than Los Altos products.

Mezcal

All tequila is mezcal, just as all cognac is brandy: Tequila and its surroundings are actually a place where famous mezcals are made. Most top quality mezcals come from the area around Oaxaca in southern Mexico.

Mixtos

These tequilas are made from 51% blue agave and perfect for a margarita or a traditional salt-shot-lime routine.

Reposados

These smooth, golden hued tequilas are aged in wood for 2–11 months and are excellent for sipping.

Tequila

Tequila is produced mostly in the western Mexican state of Jalisco. There are two key areas, the lowlands, close to the town of Tequila, 56 km to the west of the city of Guadalajara and Los Altos, or the highlands around the same distance to the northeast.

Lowland Tequilas

(3174) Iguana Reserve Reposado

This is a mix of 100% blue agave tequilas, mainly from the earthier tasting lowlands but it also includes some of the more floral highland spirits. We've specially aged this blend in the small bourbon barrels at the back of Café Iguana, which impart a lovely color and woody sweetness. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

Cabo Wabo

Sammy Haggard, sometime front-man for rock group Van Halen, owns the company that makes Cabo Wabo, which was named after his famous nightclub in Cabo San Lucas in Baja California. Perhaps surprisingly the Red Rocker makes excellent tequila that has garnered glowing reviews and a winner of best of show from the American Tasting Institute.

(3018) Cabo Wabo Blanco

Unaged 100% agave tequila that makes a great margarita or sip it straight and taste for notes of fruit and pepper. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3167) Cabo Wabo Reposado

Aged 4 to 6 months in oak casks for a smoother, richer flavor. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Casa Noble

Founded in the 1700s as a hacienda, Casa Noble was one of tequila's largest producers in 1900 and now makes only top-quality 100% agave tequilas.

(3035) Casa Noble Reposado

A wonderfully refined tequila that is mooth, sensuous and full-bodied, a rival to the best spirits in the world. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3032) Casa Noble Crystal

A double gold medal winner at the San Francisco World Spirits competition that is triple distilled in the town of Tequila. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Don Eduardo

The premium brand of Orendain is one of Mexico's 4 largest tequila producers.

(3028) Don Eduardo Silver

Triple distilled for extra smoothness. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3253) Don Eduardo Añejo

Made from estate grown agave and aged in used bourbon barrels. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Herradura

Herradura, which also makes the El Jimador brand, is a tequila giant that is second only to Jose Cuervo in volume of production but remains well-respected for the quality of its products.

(3008) Herradura Blanco

Don't mistake this one for the Herradura Silver. Unaged and 92 proof (46% - most tequilas are 40%, which is the maximum allowed by US law), this blanco is rarely found outside of Mexico because the producers believe only the locals can handle a slightly more potent tequila. An excellent choice for margarita. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3031) Herradura Silver

While most blanco tequilas get no wood aging, Herradura's receives 40 days in oak before bottling, making for an exceptionally smooth spirit that does not hide the agave fruit. It also shows nice earth and pepper notes with a bit of citrus character. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3007) Hacienda del Cristero Blanco

Made in honor of a famous revolutionary/tequila-maker from the 1922–26 Cristero War who was forced to flee Mexico, this spirit offers an incredibly rich expression of agave fruit, with awesome complexity – without a doubt one of the great blancos from one of the world’s great producers. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3139) Herradura Reposado

One of the tequilas that sets the standard for the industry and a great value with elegant caramel flavors with a slowly emerging heat. Aged 11-13 months in white American oak. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3223) Herradura Añejo

Moderate earthy aromas, slightly spicy, fruity and floral with loads of oaky, caramelized aromas and a prominent, heavy, ripe apple aroma. Medium bodied and full flavored but not sweet. Slight to moderate earthy agave flavors with slight pepper and lots of oak and caramel flavor. Long oaky finish that is reminiscent of a good bourbon whisky. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Jose Cuervo

Owned by the giant British drinks company Daigeo, Cuervo is the world’s largest producer of tequila and has over 40 million agave plants under cultivation.

(3021) José Cuervo Gold (Mixto)

Some tequila in this mix sees a bit of wood age in huge oak barrels. A bit of sweetness in the Cuervo style. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3144) Jose Cuervo Tradicional

Cuervo’s least well-known and appreciated brand but still an excellent tequila. Tradicional has a silver hue and a lively, peppery, true tequila taste. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3224) Cuervo 1800 Añejo

A premium tequila aged in new French oak barrels, it is full of agave aromas and has nice body and excellent wood character – very smooth and slightly sweet in the style typical of Cuervo. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3225) José Cuervo Reserva de la Familia

Aged 3 years in brand new oak, very sweet with subtle agave flavor that deepens with a caramel finish. A great introduction to aged tequila that is quite reminiscent of calvados and armagnac. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Sauza

One of the famous tequila brands. Check out our tequila mural that is a reproduction of one that hangs at the Sauza distillery.

(3159) Sauza Hornitos

Strong, mellow attack, with moderate, agave complexity. Caramel and pepper aromas followed by citrus and lilac. Sweet and full in the mouth. Aftertaste is long and tingly with just a hint of mint and smoky bitterness from 3 months of aging. One of the tequila’s best values for 100% blue agave. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3232) Sauza Conmemorativo Añejo (Mixto)

Some of the agave spirit receives 2 years of age and is responsible for an excellent smoothness. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

Other Lowland Reposados

(3107) Arete Reposado

Made by the Orendain family in Tequila. Lightly smoky nose, ultra-smooth palate, 4-6 months bourbon ageing. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3108) Arraigo Reposado

Sweet, oaky and from Zapopan just outside of Guadalajara. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3115) Casta Reposado

Check out the bottle in the shape of an agave worm. Each one takes eight workers fifteen minutes to handcraft - the tequila is aged for slightly under a year with flavors of spice, citrus and black pepper. BIG SHOT 35.99, Shot 24.99

(3116) Cava Don Augustin Reposado

Special, limited production bottling from a highly respected producer. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3127) Don Tacho Reserve Reposado

A pungent lowland tequila aged for 9 months in old oak. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3131) El Destilador Reposado

From the city of Zapopan in the valley of Tequila. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3133) El Tequileño Reposado

Offers pungent agave flavors from 2 months in US oak. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3146) La Perseverancia Reposado

Made in the same factory as Patrón and Sieta Leguas, this oaky and pungent tequila is not usually found outside of Mexico. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3265) Porfidio Reposado

Tequila’s first super-premium brand that has gone on to become famous and then infamous. This is a wonderful opportunity to taste a spirit that helped spark the quality tequila revolution but sadly is no longer made. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3153) Pura Sangre Reposado

Modest agave with lots of smoke, pepper, and creosote in the nose. Slightly sweet. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3154) Regional Reposado

Good agave character with smoky notes from 4 months of aging in used-oak, bourbon barrels. 1000 ml Bottle 444.99, 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3156) Revolucionario 501 Reposado

Very faint oak flavors and a favorite in France. 700 ml Bottle 233.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3026) XQ Plata

A relative new-comer to the market this is a super-premium product distilled in the town of Tequila. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Other Lowland Anejos

(3266) Reserva del Dueño Añejo

Generous agave and herb aromas carry a very slight wood accent. A rounded entry leads to a clean, medium-bodied palate, with a subtle drying, woody quality. Precise, snappy finish. Made at the same distillery as El Viejito and Hussongs and former producers of Patrón. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Centinela

Centinela is produced in the Los Altos town of Arandas by a family-owned company that has made tequila since 1894.

(3118) Centinela Imperial Reposado

Aged for 4 months in used Kentucky and Tennessee oak, a delicate tequila with a touch of oak flavor. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3119) Centinela Reposado

Aged 4 months in American white oak, soft fruit and cinnamon flavor. Excellent intensity and some pungency on the attack. White pepper aromas dominate, backed up with good fruit and oak. Slightly sweet with a medium mouth feel. Agave is also at the front of flavor with moderate oak, caramel and pepper. The finish has little bitterness and some sweetness. The flavors of caramel and agave last a long time. BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3220) Centinela Añejo

Macho intensity and suave complexity with a mellow attack. White pepper and light smoke combine with vanilla and caramel on the nose. Plenty of delicate, earthy agave aromas and flavors. A nice balance of fruit, floral and oak elements. Caramel, vanilla and smoke mix together for a long-lasting, gentle finish. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Corazon

Produced in an ultramodern distillery set in a famous tequila growing area near Arandas. The Espolon brand also is made in this distillery.

(3033) Corazon Blanco

This blanco was ranked first in tastings by the Beverage Testing Institute of Chicago with a score of 93. The BTI review reads, "Clear. Lush spicy agave nose. Medium-full body. Substantial mouth feel. Rich, smooth agave palate with delicate pineapple fruit notes and a surprising peppery snap at the finish." 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3036) Corazon Reposado

Made in an ultra-modern factory that is set amongst picturesque red soil and agave that is literally blue. This brand is often very highly rated by reviewers. From the makers of Espolon. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Don Julio

Now owned by Jose Cuervo, Don Julio is one of the worlds most respected and sought after brands.

(3015) Don Julio Silver

This tequila comes straight out of distillation into bottles. It shows a bit of sweetness and some vanilla notes as if it had seen some wood aging and a bit of herbaceous and spicy qualities as well. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3209) Don Julio 1942

Comes in a great, agave-shaped bottle that contains one of the finest tequilas made by Julio González Estrada who is amongst the most esteemed makers of super-premium tequila. 750 ml Bottle 833.99, BIG SHOT 49.99, Shot 34.99

(3210) Don Julio Real Añejo

The ultimate from Don Julio Gonzales, one of Mexico's most renowned premium tequila makers. This is out most expensive and lavish tequila. 750 ml Bottle 2,099.99, BIG SHOT 139.99, Shot 99.99

El Charro

We proudly feature El Charro products because of their excellent quality and great value.

(3140) El Charro Silver

From Arandas in the Jalisco highlands, an excellent, unaged tequila sent to us by Javier Martinez. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3129) El Charro Reposado

A great value made in a relatively new distillery by a highly respected *tequilero*. Shows *macho* intensity, earthy agave aromas and a bit of sweetness. The first flavor to hit is caramel, closely followed by agave, pepper and oak. 1000 ml Bottle 199.99, BIG SHOT 7.99, Shot 5.99

(3203) El Charro Añejo

Small batches, triple distillation and 2 years in French oak barrels make this a wonderfully smooth and and balanced tequila. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

El Conquistador

(3130) El Conquistador Reposado

Aged for 7 months, rich, smooth citrus flavors. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

El Tesoro

This is one of the world's great distillers. Located in Arandas, El Tesoro is about as artisanal as a producer can be and still employs a donkey to crush the agaves, which are all fermented in open wooden vats then distilled to 80%. El Tesoro is one of the few producers that never "cuts" their tequila with water.

(3134) El Tesoro de Don Felipe Reposado

Aged 9 months in new white oak barrels, a robust nose, revealing subtle oak and vanilla mellowed from the softness of barrel aging. This is an awesome tequila, definitely one of the best. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3205) El Tesoro de Don Filipe Añejo

Another exceptional tequila from El Tesoro, which is aged 2-3 years to give a luxuriously rich product with a minty character and a harmonious balance of oak and fruity agave. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3267) El Tesoro Paradiso

Paradiso is an innovative tequila. It is made from a blend of El Tesoro silver and añejo tequilas carefully selected for their distinctive characteristics. The blend is aged a further five years in cognac barrels, which give this tequila less sweetness than those aged in bourbon barrels. 750 ml Bottle 833.99, BIG SHOT 49.99, Shot 34.99

Gran Centenario

Made in the highland town of Zaptlanejo in a distillery owned by Jose Cuervo, Gran Centenario is an definitely a top-flight tequila

(3006) Gran Centenario Plata

This small production super-premium sees a bit of wood aging in new, white oak casks to give it a lovely smoothness for a blanco. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3136) Gran Centenario Reposado

This is a top of the range product and even at a rather hefty price it is great value for the excellent taste and complexity. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3222) Gran Centenario Añejo

Aged for 18 months in new US oak to give a nice balance of wood and spice this is undoubtedly a great tequila at an excellent price for a product of such quality. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Milagro

Milagro mean miracle in Spanish and this tequila is triple-distilled, hand-crafted product that sees extended aging.

(3158) Milagro Reposado

Aged for 6 months in white oak casks to bring out its velvety nature. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3254) Milagro Romance

Check out the special "Romance" bottle, which offers a combination of reposado in the outside cylinder and añejo in the inner chamber. BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3251) Milagro Añejo

This añejo gets 18 months of oak aging. BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Oro Azul

An artisanal brand made by the Garibay family outside the small town of Jesus Maria.

(3011) Oro Azul Blanco

Very dry, light to medium-bodied with smoky roasted pepper and spice notes. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3208) Oro Azul Añejo

Aging over two years in charred oak barrels give this tequila a deep vanilla and pickling spice nose. The round entry leads to an off-dry, medium body with sweet toffee, brown spice, salt, leather, tobacco and green pepper flavors. It finishes gracefully with a fruity, agave-driven notes. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Patron

Patrón is produced and blended in a facility high in the mountains of Jalisco. It is one of America's most recognized and prized labels of super-premium tequila.

(3168) Patrón Reposado

An excellent reputation for richness and complexity. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

San Matias

"La Casa San Matias" is amongst the world's oldest tequila producers. It is run by Carmelita Roman one of the tequila regions few women in a top position as well as one of its most respected leaders. San Matias also produces the Pueblo Viejo brand.

(3231) San Matias Añejo

Aged in Jack Daniels barrels. 375 ml Bottle 208.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3211) Rey Sol Añejo

This fantastic tequila comes inside a bottle designed by the famous Mexican artist Sergio Bustamante. The "Sun King" of tequila is aged for five years in oak casks at 750 ml Bottle 1,999.99, BIG SHOT 129.99, Shot 89.99

Tesoro

A highly respected brand the first bottle of which was given to Café Iguana by the former Mexican Ambassador to Singapore, HE Eduardo Ramos-Gomez.

(3250) Tesoro Azteca Reposado Imperial

Check out the special commemorative bottling. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3161) Tesoro Azteca Reposado

This light golden tequila is matured in small white barrels in Jalisco. 1000ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Other Los Altos Reposados

(3109) Atalaje Reposado

A rare tequila but despite that it is often found on some of the world's best tequila lists. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3111) Campanario Reposado

From a beautiful distillery in the highland town of San Ignacio Cerro Gordo, where music is played to aid fermentation. 1000 ml Bottle 444.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3112) Campo Azul Reposado

Produced in the highland village of Jesus Maria. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3122) Chimayo Reposado

Aged in 8 months in French oak for smoothness but less sweet than other reposados aged in bourbon barrels. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3135) Espolon Reposado

Made at the same high tech distillery as Corazon but generally only available in Mexico. Very floral aroma with agave, leather and caramel tinges leading to an oaky finish. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3127) Hacienda de Tepa Reposado

A light style of reposado that gets only 2 months of aging in wood. Made by the same producers as El Charro. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3141) Honorable Reposado

From La Laja with orange and other citrus flavors. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3166) Hussong's Reposado

Pale color, oaky, earthy flavors with sweet vanilla, almond and chocolate aromas. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3142) Jarro Viejo Reposado

From Tapatitlan, it has a pleasant agave taste, a nice gold color and is aged in oak, bourbon barrels for 11 months. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3147) Las Trancas Reposado

Extremely smooth with citrus flavors and a complex nose. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3151) Perrísimo Reposado

A very pale straw coloured tequila that is quite light and floral. 750 ml Bottle 249.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3163) Tres Magueyes Reposado

From the makers of Don Julio. Nice intensity and complexity. Cream soda aromas mix with earthy agave and overripe apple. Slightly sweet and full in the mouth. Vanilla, caramel, agave, and apple flavors. Tingly finish, with a hint of bitterness and a long duration of flavors. Smooth agave character, nice caramel flavor, gentle heat. 1000 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 14.99, Shot 9.99

(3104) 7 Leguas Reposado

Named for Pancho Villa's horse. Pale yellow color, pungent and full flavored from 6 months of aging in oak. *Macho* agave intensity with good complexity. Agave, ginseng, and caramel are the primary aromas. Slightly sweet and full in the mouth. Caramel and toasty oak flavors overlay the earthy agave and ginseng. One of Mexico's most famous super-premiums. 1000 ml Bottle 444.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

Other Los Altos Anejos

(3202) D'Antano Añejo

The top tequila from Siete Leguas a well respected traditional producer that has been responsible for distilling the highly regarded Patrón brand. 750 ml Bottle 833.99, BIG SHOT 49.99, Shot 34.99

(3227) El Puente Viejo Añejo

Made at Tequilera Newton e Hijos which is also famous for the Casta Reposado in the worm bottle. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3226) Pueblo Viejo Añejo

2 years aging in Jack Daniels barrels gives oak and fruit flavors and as with their reposado there is great balance between the main tequila characteristics of fruit, earth and wood. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3266) Reserva del Dueño Añejo

Generous agave and herb aromas carry a very slight wood accent. A rounded entry leads to a clean, medium-bodied palate, with a subtle drying, woody quality. Precise, snappy finish. Made at the same distillery as El Viejo and Hussongs and former producers of Patrón. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

(3234) Sol de México Añejo

From La Laja in the highlands of Jalisco. 750 ml Bottle 416.99, BIG SHOT 24.99, Shot 19.99

Other Tequilas

Chinaco

Chinaco is a super-premium brand made by the Gonzales family that pioneered the growing of Weber Blue Agave in the northern state of Tamaulipas when the practice was made legal in 1973.

(3034) Chinaco Blanco

This is a *muy macho* blanco with a complex aroma of white pepper, citrus, chamomile and smoke layered with hints of caramel and loads of earthy agave. The mouth feel is medium and dry. The flavors follow the aroma. Spice, fruit, floral, and caramel add support to deep earthy agave flavors. The hot finish is medium to long, with little bitterness and moderate sweetness. The finishing flavor is pure agave with hints of smoke and cream soda. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3121) Chinaco Reposado

The aroma has bits of everything dominated by agave and white pepper, built on layers of smoke and floral notes with touches of fruit and caramel. The mouth feel is medium and barely sweet. The flavors have moderate spice and caramel, hints of fruit, flowers and oak and loads of earthy agave. The aftertaste is moderate in both bitterness and sweetness. 750 ml Bottle 333.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 14.99

(3252) Chinaco Añejo

The aromas are intense, dominated by earthy agave with a strong presence of pepper, citrus, chamomile, caramel, smoke and butterscotch. The tequila is oily, yet dry, an amazing accomplishment. Huge agave and caramel flavors are balanced by fruit, floral, oak and butterscotch with a bit of white pepper. The aftertaste is low on bitterness and moderate on sweetness. Corralejo

From a wonderful distillery in the Mexican state of Guanajuato where technically tequila can be made, this distillery uses copper stills and traditional methods exclusively. But there is some controversy about Corralejo because although it makes a 100% Agave product and not a mixto not all designations are made from 100% Weber Blue Agave so these bottles by law cannot say 100% Agave on their labels. Taste it and decide for yourself whether it stacks up with other super-premium products.

(3466) Corralejo Blanco
